### Scope of Application

Meilong Lock—Semi-Permanent Connecting Carabiner.

Do not exceed the product's limitations when using it. This product must not be used for any purpose other than those described in the instruction manual.

### Inspections

Your safety is closely tied to the condition of your equipment.

We recommend conducting a comprehensive inspection at least once every 12 months.

#### **Before Each Use**

- Check for any deformation, cracks, scratches, wear, or corrosion (on the lock body and locking sleeve);
- Check that the locking sleeve locks and unlocks properly.

#### **During Each Use**

Check that the Meilong lock is bearing the load on the recommended load-bearing axis.

Frequently check that the locking sleeve is engaged. Avoid pressure or friction that could cause the locking sleeve to open or become damaged. It is critical to frequently inspect the product's condition and its connections to other equipment within the system. Ensure that all equipment within the system is properly connected to one another.

### Compatibility

This product is part of a safety system. Verify the compatibility of this product with other equipment used in conjunction with it.

### Recommended Load-Bearing Shaft

No Mei Long Lock is indestructible.

The Mei Long Lock achieves maximum strength when loaded on the recommended shaft and when the locking sleeve is engaged.

Loading the Mei Long Lock in any other manner is dangerous and reduces its strength, such as when loaded on a secondary shaft.

### Tightening Recommendations

Tighten the door lock with a wrench.

### Additional Information

The Meilong Lock must be connected to a closed attachment point.

- Using wide, flat webbing may compromise strength.
- When using any equipment in conjunction with this product, strictly follow its instructions for use;
- Instructions for use must be provided to the user in the language of the country where the product is used;
- Please place the instructions for use removed from the equipment in a permanent file for future reference.

### Retiring Your Equipment:
